Andrejs Surotkins (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Vasyl Koval and Libby Stein Also Known As Koval (the 'Tenants') because the Landlord requires

possession of the rental unit for the purpose of residential occupation.

This application was heard in Toronto on February 25, 2008.

The Landlord representative, Barrington Lue Sang and the Tenant representative, Michael Rogers attended the hearing.

At the hearing, the parties settled the application and jointly requested that the order that follows issue on consent of the parties. They have agreed that the tenancy will terminate on March 31, 2008, and on that basis the Tenant has indicated he will pay the Landlord the rent for March, 2008, on March 1, 2008.

it is ordered that:

- 1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before March 31, 2008.
- 2. The Landlord may file this order with the Sheriff forthwith, but it shall not be enforced until on or after April 1, 2008.
- 3. If the unit is not vacated on or before March 31, 2008, then starting April 1, 2008, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) may enforce the eviction.

4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after April 1, 2008.
