



## Order under Section 78(6) Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

John Miller (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Matthew Jones (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the mediated settlement signed by the parties on with respect to application LTB-L-014151-22.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

### Determinations:

1. The mediated settlement provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy, evict the Tenant and for an order to have the Tenant pay the rent they owe because the Tenant failed to meet certain conditions in the mediated settlement. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following conditions specified in the mediated settlement: **The Tenant failed to pay the arrears of \$500.00 on September 27, 2022, the Tenant failed to pay the lawful monthly rent on or before October 1, 2022 and the Tenant also failed to pay the arrears in the amount of \$200.00 due on or before October 2, 2022.**
3. The previous application includes a request for an order for the payment of arrears of rent and the mediated settlement requires the Tenant to make payments by specific due dates. Accordingly, in addition to eviction, the Landlord is entitled to request an order for the payment of arrears owing.
4. The Tenant was required to pay \$3,516.00 for rent arrears and the application filing fee in the previous mediated settlement. The amount that is still owing from that mediated settlement is \$3,516.00 and that amount is included in this order.

5. Since the date of the previous mediated settlement, the Tenant has failed to pay the full rent that became owing for the period from October 1, 2022 to October 31, 2022. This order replaces order LTB-L-014151-22.
6. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$600.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord.
7. Interest on the rent deposit is owing to the Tenant for the period from October 28, 2021 to January 09, 2023.
8. The amount of the rent deposit and interest on the rent deposit is applied to the amount the Tenant is required to pay.
9. The Landlord is entitled to daily compensation from the day after this order is issued to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit at a daily rate of \$19.73. This amount is calculated as follows: \$600.00 x 12, divided by 365 days.

**It is ordered that:**

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before January 20, 2023.
2. If the unit is not vacated on or before January 20, 2023, then starting January 21, 2023, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
3. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after January 21, 2023.
4. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$4,879.14\*.**(Less any payments made by the Tenants after this application was filed on October 5, 2022).** This amount represents the rent owing up to January 09, 2023, less the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit.
5. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord \$19.73 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting January 10, 2023 to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
6. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before January 20, 2023, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be a simple interest calculated from January 21, 2023 at 2.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
