On October 22, 2021, Diana Lozada and Camilo Ramirez Varela (the 'Landlords') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Lorraine Bohnhert, Beth Lovegrove and Arianne Bohnhert (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants entered into an agreement to terminate the tenancy.

Determinations:

1. The Landlords and the Tenants signed an agreement to terminate the tenancy as of April 1, 2022.
2. Since the application was filed on a no-fault basis, before the termination date, it is not appropriate to require the Tenants to pay the application filing fee as costs.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlords and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before April 1, 2022.
2. If the unit is not vacated on or before April 1, 2022, then starting April 2, 2022, the Landlords may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
3. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlords on or after April 2, 2022.

The tenant has until December 9, 2021 to file a motion with the Board to set aside the order under s. 77(6) of the Act. If the tenant files the motion by December 9, 2021 the order will be stayed and the Board will schedule a hearing.
