Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Dinesh Jeganathan (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Hala Fadlahmed ('HF1'), Hala Fadlahmed ('HF2') and Ali Bashir Abdul-Hafith ('AA', the 'Tenants') because the Landlord requires possession of the rental unit for the purpose of residential occupation.

This application was heard in video conference room 115 on August 17, 2021.

The Landlord, the Landlord's representative, E. Anani, and the Tenant AA attended the hearing.

Determinations:

- 1. The Landlord's declaration does not comply with the requirements of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'). Subsection 72(1)(a) of the Act requires that the declaration expressly state that the Landlord will occupy the rental unit for at least one year. I therefore find that an implied statement to that effect, as the Landlord's representative suggested, is in adequate.
- 2. The Landlord's application shall accordingly be dismissed, without prejudice. The Landlord may serve a new notice of termination.
- 3. The Landlord paid compensation to the Tenants on or about April 27, 2021. The Tenants shall immediately pay the Landlord back the compensation, pursuant to subsection 73.1(1) of the Act.

It is ordered that:

- 1. The Landlord's application is dismissed.
- 2. The Tenants shall immediately pay the Landlord back the amount of compensation the Landlord paid to the Tenants.
