Q Res V Operating LP (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Emma Krzyworaczka and Gabriel Krzyworaczka (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants gave a notice to terminate the tenancy.

Determinations:

1. The Tenants gave the Landlord a notice to terminate their tenancy effective September 30, 2021 and they did not move out of the rental unit by the termination date set out in the notice.

It is ordered that:

- 1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before December 6, 2021.
- 2. The Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$201.00 for the cost of filing the application.
- 3. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before December 6, 2021, they will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from December 7, 2021 at 2.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
- 4. If the unit is not vacated on or before December 6, 2021, then starting December 7, 2021, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
- 5. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after December 7, 2021.
