



Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Sultan Kaplan (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Christine Wynn and John Corbiere (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

This application was heard by videoconference on June 17, 2021. Only the Landlord's Legal Representative, Adrienne Hagan, attended the hearing. As of 1:36 p.m., the Tenants were not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the Board.

Determinations:

1. The Tenants have not paid the total rent the Tenants were required to pay for the period from October 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021. Because of the arrears, the Landlord served a Notice of Termination effective November 30, 2020.
2. The Tenants are in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful monthly rent is \$792.00.
4. The Landlord is not holding a last month's rent deposit.
5. The Tenants have made no payments since the application was filed.
6. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (RTA), including the impact of COVID-19 on the parties and whether the Landlord attempted to negotiate a repayment agreement with the Tenant, and find that it **would be** unfair to grant relief from eviction pursuant to subsection 83(1) of the Act.

It is ordered that:

1. Unless the Tenants void the order as set out below, the tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before July 5, 2021.
2. The Tenants shall pay to the Landlord **\$8,521.24***, which represents the amount of rent owing and compensation up to June 24, 2021.
3. The Tenants shall also pay to the Landlord **\$26.04** per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting June 25, 2021 to the date the Tenants move out of the unit.
4. The Tenants shall also pay to the Landlord **\$186.00** for the cost of filing the application.
5. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing* on or before July 5, 2021, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from July 6, 2021 at 2.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
6. If the unit is not vacated on or before July 5, 2021, then starting July 6, 2021, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
7. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord, on or after July 6, 2021.
8. If the Tenants wish to void this order and continue the tenancy, the Tenants must pay to the Landlord or to the Board in trust:
 - i) **\$8,887.00** if the payment is made on or before June 30, 2021, or
 - ii) **\$9,679.00** if the payment is made on or before July 5, 2021**.If the Tenants do not make full payment in accordance with this paragraph and by the appropriate deadline, then the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
9. The Tenants may make a motion to the Board under subsection 74(11) of the Act to set aside this order if they pay the amount required under that subsection on or after July 6, 2021 but before the Sheriff gives vacant possession to the Landlord. The Tenants are only entitled to make this motion once during the period of the tenancy agreement with the Landlord.
