



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

1634658 Ontario Inc and 1634658 Ontario Inc (the 'Landlords') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Jake William Seymour (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on June 15, 2023. Only the Landlords' legal agent, A. Toor, attended the hearing. As of 9:58 a.m., the Tenant was not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlords' evidence.

Determinations:

L1 Application

1. The Landlords served the Tenant with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Nonpayment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenant did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$1,590.19. It is due on the 1st day of each month.

4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$52.28. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,590.19 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenant has paid \$1,000.00 to the Landlords since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to June 30, 2023 are \$22,558.94.
7. The Landlords incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlords collected a rent deposit of \$1,500.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlords. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$77.51 is owing to the Tenant for the period from October 1, 2019 to June 15, 2023.

L2 Application

10. On August 31, 2022, the Landlord gave the Tenant an N8 notice of termination. The notice of termination alleges that the Tenant persistently failed to pay the rent when it was due.
11. Rent is due on the first of each month.
12. As per the N8 Notice, the Tenant had not paid rent in full by the first of the month five times.
13. The Tenant has persistently failed to pay the rent on the date it was due.

Relief from Eviction

14. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), including the impact of COVID-19 on the parties and whether the Landlord attempted to negotiate a repayment agreement with the Tenant, and find that it would be unfair to grant relief from eviction pursuant to subsection 83(1) of the Act.
15. Pursuant to section 83(6), the Landlord submitted that several attempts were made to negotiate a repayment plan. However, the Tenant was unresponsive. I am satisfied that the Landlord attempted to negotiate a payment agreement with the Tenant.
16. Regarding section 83(2), the Tenant was not present to disclose any circumstances for me to consider delaying or denying eviction. Further, the Landlord was not aware of any of the Tenant's circumstances for me to consider delaying or denying eviction.

It is ordered that:

1. Pursuant to the L2 Application, the tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before July 17, 2023.
2. The Tenant shall pay the Landlord any rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing. The amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenant.
3. As of the date of the hearing, the Tenant owes the Landlord \$20,361.44. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
4. The Tenant shall also pay the Landlord daily rent/compensation of \$52.28 per day for the use of the unit starting June 16, 2023 to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
5. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before July 17, 2023, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from July 18, 2023 at 6.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
6. If the unit is not vacated on or before July 17, 2023, then starting July 18, 2023, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
7. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after July 18, 2023.
