



## **Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Thi Hoa Tran (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Dawn-Marie Turner and William Joseph Turner (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

This application was heard by videoconference on June 7, 2023. The Landlord's legal representative, T. Currie, and the Tenants attended the hearing.

**Determinations:**

1. The Landlord served the Tenants with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Nonpayment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenants did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenants was still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$1,800.00. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$59.18. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,800.00 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenants has not made any payments since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to June 30, 2023 are \$16,200.00.

7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,800.00 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$38.59 is owing to the Tenants for the period from July 30, 2022 to June 7, 2023.
10. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), including the impact of COVID-19 on the parties and whether the Landlord attempted to negotiate a repayment agreement with the Tenants and find that it would not be unfair to postpone the eviction until July 31, 2023 pursuant to subsection 83(1)(b) of the Act.
11. The Tenants submitted that they are seeking to terminate the tenancy for July 31, 2023. They are looking for a place where they do not have to use the stairs as they have health issues. The Landlord objected to the extended termination date as the Tenants have previously accrued substantial arrears at a previous unit and alluded to their health issues to request an extended termination date. Further, the Landlord has been required to pay for the mortgage out of pocket.
12. In consideration of all the circumstances, I find it would not be unfair to extend termination of the tenancy. Even if the Tenants disclosed their health issues for a previous arrears hearing, I find it unlikely that the Tenants are fabricated their health issues. The extended period will provide the Tenants some time to organize their move.

**It is ordered that:**

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants voids this order.
  2. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
    - \$16,386.00 if the payment is made on or before June 30, 2023. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
- OR**
- \$18,186.00 if the payment is made on or before July 31, 2023. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
  3. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenants has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after July 31, 2023 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenants may only make this motion once during the tenancy.

4. **If the Tenants do not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before July 31, 2023**
5. If the Tenants do not void the order, the Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$13,161.67. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenants. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
6. The Tenants shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$59.18 per day for the use of the unit starting June 8, 2023 until the date the Tenants moves out of the unit.
7. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before July 3, 2023, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from July 4, 2023 at 6.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
8. The Landlord or the Tenants shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.
9. If the unit is not vacated on or before July 31, 2023, then starting August 1, 2023, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
10. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after August 1, 2023.
