



Order under Section 78(6) Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Minto Multi-Res Income Prtnrs 1 and GP (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Roger Lavallee-Sauve (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on May 19, 2023, with respect to application LTB-L-069749-22.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following condition(s) specified in the order:
 - a) **The Tenant failed to pay the full \$1,800.00 towards arrears on or before May 9, 2023.**
 - b) **The Tenant failed to pay the full \$600.00 towards arrears on or before May 12, 2023.**

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-069749-22 is cancelled.
2. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before June 24, 2023.

3. If the unit is not vacated on or before June 24, 2023, then starting June 25, 2023, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after June 25, 2023.
