



## Order under Section 78(6) Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

On March 20, 2023, Franco Mastromatteo and Jonathan Burkholder (the 'Landlords') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Timothy Corrigan (the 'Tenant') and for an order to have the Tenant pay the rent they owe because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on February 1, 2023, with respect to application LTB-L-027827-22.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

### Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlords can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.

2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following condition specified in the order:

**The Tenant failed to pay to the Landlords \$1,000.00 on or before March 17, 2023, towards arrears of rent. The Tenant paid \$500.00.**

3. The previous application includes a request for an order for the payment of arrears of rent and the order requires the Tenant to make payments by specific due dates. Accordingly, in addition to eviction, the Landlords are entitled to request an order for the payment of arrears owing.

4. The Tenant was required to pay \$16,686.00 for rent arrears and the application filing fee in the previous order. The amount that is still owing from that order is \$10,686.00 and that amount is included in this order. This order replaces order LTB-L-027827-22.

5. Since the date of the previous order, the Tenant has failed to pay the full rent that became owing for the period from February 1, 2023, to March 31, 2023.
6. The Landlords collected a rent deposit of \$1,500.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlords.
7. Interest on the rent deposit is owing to the Tenant for the period from February 1, 2021, to May 1, 2023.
8. The amount of the rent deposit and interest on the rent deposit is applied to the amount the Tenant is required to pay.
9. The Landlords are entitled to daily compensation from the day after this order is issued to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit at a daily rate of \$49.32. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,500.00 x 12, divided by 365 days.

**It is ordered that:**

1. Order LTB-L-027827-22 is cancelled.
2. The tenancy between the Landlords and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before May 12, 2023.
3. If the unit is not vacated on or before May 12, 2023, then starting May 13, 2023, the Landlords may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlords on or after May 13, 2023.
5. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$10,704.89\* (**Less any payments made by the Tenant after this application was filed on March 20, 2023**). This amount represents the rent owing up to May 1, 2023, and the cost of filing the previous application, less the rent deposit and interest the Landlords owe on the rent deposit.
6. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord \$49.32 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting May 2, 2023, to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
7. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlords the full amount owing on or before May 12, 2023, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be a simple interest calculated from May 13, 2023, at 6.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
