SATINDERPAL SAINI (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict KATELYNN DAWN FURY and MICHAEL DANIEL JOSEPH PROULX (the 'Tenants') because the Tenant entered into an agreement to terminate the tenancy.

The Landlord's application was resolved by order LTB-L-071988-22, issued on December 6, 2022. This order was issued without a hearing being held.

The Tenant filed a motion to set aside order LTB-L-071988-22.

The motion was heard by videoconference on January 5, 2023.

Only the Landlord attended the hearing.

As of 1:57 p.m., the Tenants were not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing.

Determinations:

 As the Tenants did not attend the hearing to present their motion to set aside, the Tenant's motion is dismissed as abandoned/denied.

It is ordered that:

- 1. The motion to set aside Order LTB-L-071988-22, issued on December 6, 2022, is denied.
- 2. The stay of Order LTB-L-071988-22 is lifted immediately.
