



**Order under Subsection 87(1)
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

PANORAMIC PROPERTIES INC. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order requiring ALAIN JOSEPH BOULAY (the 'Tenant') to pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on October 26, 2022.

Only the Landlord's Legal Representative Jennifer Ricci and the Landlord's Agent Lauren Brace attended the hearing.

As of 1:43 p.m., the Tenant was not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. Since the Tenant did not attend and the Landlord was prepared to proceed, the matter proceeded by way of an uncontested hearing pursuant to section 7 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, R.S.O. 1990.

Determinations:

1. At the hearing the Landlord's Legal Representative relied on oral submissions and referred to documents to support their application.
2. Based on the uncontested evidence of the Landlord's Legal Representative, I find the Tenant vacated the rental unit on October 25, 2022. The Landlord inspected the unit the day prior to the hearing and found it empty and they keys were left inside the unit. The Tenant was in possession of the rental unit on the date the application was filed.
3. The Tenant did not pay the total rent they were required to pay for the period from June 1, 2022 to October 25, 2022.
4. The lawful rent was \$1,099.00 and increased to \$1112.18 on October 1, 2022. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
5. The Tenant has not made any payments since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears and daily compensation owing to October 25, 2022 are \$5,309.00

7. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,099.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit is applied to the arrears of rent because the tenancy is terminated.
8. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$17.26 is owing to the Tenant for the period from September 24, 2022 until October 25, 2022.
9. The Landlord incurred costs of \$201.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy is terminated effective October 25, 2022.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$4,393.74*. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to October 25, 2022 and the cost of the application minus the rent deposit and interest owing.
3. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before November 27, 2022, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from November 28, 2022 at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
