Sibusiso Mutetwa and Marshall Tsiga (the 'Landlords') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Tanaka Magama and Kayla Mulunda (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

This application was heard by videoconference on September 18, 2024.

The Landlord's Legal Representative, Jimmy Gangadin, and the Tenants attended the hearing.

At the hearing, the parties consented to the following order.

## It is ordered on consent that:

- 1. The Landlord shall waive all rent owing and the filing fee.
- 2. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants shall be terminated as of November 15, 2024.
- 3. If the unit is not vacated on or before November 15, 2024, then starting November 16, 2024, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
- 4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlords on or after November 16, 2024.
